


1. The Company

Souter Investments is one of the UK's leading family investment offices focused on private equity.

Founded in 2006, they have invested in over 55 unquoted companies deploying more than £400m in capital. They currently have significant investments in around 25 businesses, acting either as the lead investor or as a co-investor with other financial sponsors.

Over more than 13 years, Souter have demonstrated a strong track record of successful realisations achieving an aggregate 3.2x money multiple and 26% IRR across more than 25 unquoted company exits. These realisations, alongside a considerable base of liquidity, provide a strong platform from which to further grow the portfolio through future investments.

Key Responsibilities

- Review and screening of investment opportunities, including meeting management teams, business owners and entrepreneurs
- Conduct company and industry research and analysis, producing high quality internal reports that can be used to develop ideas and drive investment decisions
- Establish investment theses and value creation strategies for investment opportunities
- Perform complex analytical and valuation analysis, including detailed financial modelling:
 - o Build new financial models as required for new investments
 - Model investment valuations and sensitivities against informed and substantiated inputs and assumptions
 - Run exit scenario analysis of live investments
- Plan and assist with transaction execution, including due diligence, deal structuring and legal documentation
- Support with the preparation of investment papers and other supporting documents
- Assisting in the management of portfolio investments, working with company Boards and management teams through the investment lifecycle to ensure delivery of the agreed strategy, growth and operational and other improvement programmes, and ultimately realise value
- Completing portfolio valuation, reporting and other tasks to meet internal and external deadlines
- Other ad-hoc duties and projects as required

4. Preferred Candidate Background

In a small team, cultural fit is crucial and a significant aspect in the decision-making process. The ideal candidate will therefore have the following personal characteristics and experience:

- Strong academic record and relevant professional qualification (e.g. Chartered Accountant, CFA, MBA etc.). Likely to be sitting in a credible professional services, banking/financial services or consulting firm, with experience ranging from 1 - 3 years PQE
- Candidates from other backgrounds (e.g. operations, engineering, technology, law) with strong business and financial acumen will also be considered
- Entrepreneurial in spirit and naturally inquisitive, someone who actively questions the "why" and can rationalise/pitch their thoughts through debate



- Grounded in their approach, a professional with the right amount of credibility/maturity who can listen, extract pertinent information and then use it to support investment/business decisions
- A robust operator with a hands-on approach, someone who can demonstrate personal resilience and appropriate gravitas to support businesses through periods of change
- Capable of building lasting relationships, internally and externally, including developing a network
- Collaborative in style with excellent communication skills, both written and verbal, with an ability to draw and present concise, evidence-based conclusions and recommendations
- Strong analytical and problem-solving capabilities, with a rigorous attention to detail and accuracy. Someone who is highly organised and can prioritise what is important and relevant
- Highly numerate, with working knowledge of accounting, corporate finance and investment concepts
- High level of proficiency in excel and experience of financial modelling
- Previous experience in private equity, investment banking, corporate finance (advisory, transaction services, or business restructuring) or banking would be an advantage
