

Reporting to the Group Managing Director, the Group Head of IT will lead the strategic development, transformational change and operational management of the technology function and the overall digital capability of the organisation.



The primary responsibilities of the Head of Group IT are to provide technology vision and leadership, and to ensure the provision and management of appropriate IT services, technology, and resource levels meet the dynamic operational requirements of all Denholm companies in an environment where functionality, security, scalability, reliability, and cost-effectiveness are of fundamental importance, alongside the management of Group IT policies & standards, and monitoring compliance therewith.

Key Accountabilities:

- Develop and promote The Denholm Group IT strategy to align with Group and divisional objectives in a secure and cost-effective manner
- Identify areas where deployment of new technologies might bring business benefit
- Liaise with Group Board, Group Audit Committee, Group GDPR team, Group Insurance and divisional senior management on IT matters
- Develop and manage IT policies in conjunction with senior management
- Ensure IT projects are properly specified, managed, resourced, and authorised
- Oversee Group and divisional IT operations & systems, ensuring that:
 - o system performance is properly monitored and managed
 - o appropriate backups and data recovery measures are in operation
 - optimal levels of resilience are built into the overall IT infrastructure
 - overall IT security measures are effective
 - o adequate DR & contingency plans are in place, and
 - IT policies are followed.
- Manage out our two datacentres in line with the current Cloud migration exercise
- Manage the Group's ShareFile system, and potentially its migration to Microsoft SharePoint
- Lead, manage and coordinate two IT teams based in Glasgow and Liverpool
- Monitor and authorise IT procurement across the Group and ensure compliance with Group policies
- Prepare the annual budget for the Group IT function, and manage costs accordingly
- Manage Azure billing and ensure optimisation of costs
- Negotiate and manage Group contracts for software, hardware, and services
- Manage the performance of suppliers of Group IT services
- Negotiate mobile phones contract and ensure service quality, including monitoring of overall usage stats, contract compliance, etc
- Manage DNS and domain registration procedures, incl. SSL certificates etc.

As a strategic Technology Leader you will have the unique opportunity to lead and develop The Denholm Group's overall technology capacity and capability, and ultimately be responsible for successfully leading, directing & implementing the technology and digital strategies required to allow The Denholm Group to continue to deliver high quality, efficient and effective services with a focus on their mission and the customers they serve.
